This course incorporates Compressed Gas & Cryogenic Fluids Course 3252. The receipt, issue, storage and accounting procedures of compressed gases and cryogenic fluids. A recognition of the requirements of Health & Safety at Work and Environmental legislations. For the fuels element of the course a progress examination is required with a 75% pass mark in order to progress. There are final theory and practical examinations, also with a 75% pass mark. For the compressed gases element there are final practical and theory assessments, with a 75% pass mark.</p>
