LOCAL AREA

Innsworth is in a semi-rural location four miles from historic Gloucester and the Spa town of Cheltenham. Both offer a good range of high street stores and individual shops. Gloucester has a Designer Outlet centre, called the Quays, which is located next to the recently restored dock area and close to Gloucester Cathedral. Within Gloucester, Cheltenham and the surrounding area you have a wide range of places to eat from all the High Street names to Michelin starred restaurants. Cheltenham is famous for its race course and Kingsholme is home to Gloucester Rugby club; there is an excellent choice of sports and leisure activities for all abilities to watch or join in. There are good entertainment facilities with a local theatre, cinema, festivals offering a range of music and comedy.

Birmingham, Bristol and Cardiff are only an hour away by train or road. There is easy access to the Cotswold villages, The Forest of Dean and the Malvern hills.

UNIT OVERVIEW

The major occupant of Imjin Barracks at Innsworth is the Allied Command Europe Rapid Reaction Corps (ARRC) Headquarters and its supporting elements. The ARRC, as it is known, was formed in Germany in 1993. It is a high readiness Corps Headquarters under NATO command. Its staff are trained and equipped to deploy anywhere as required in support of NATO. The Corps Headquarters is British led, but is a fully integrated unit with staff from fourteen NATO partner nations. The ARRC has deployed previously in support of NATO missions in Bosnia-Herzegovina, Afghanistan and Kosovo.

In the summer of 2010, the ARRC transferred from its base in Germany to a new home in Gloucestershire, to the site of the former RAF Innsworth. The camp was re-named Imjin Barracks in memory of those who fought in the Battle of Imjin in the Korean War. This was considered a fitting name for the Barracks as not only did a local Regiment, The Glorious Gloucesters, fight in Imjin, but representatives of many of the partner nations now forming the ARRC Headquarters also had troops fighting there. Personnel from the ARRC are currently deployed for the second time in support of the mission in Afghanistan.

TRAVEL

By car: Unit Postcode for Sat Nav is GL3 1HW

- If travelling from the north or south leave the M5 at junction 11. Take the A40 towards Gloucester. At the roundabout take 4th exit B4063 (signed Imjin Barracks / HQ ARRC) Drive through one set of traffic lights passing a garage on your right. At the next traffic lights there is a pub (Hare & Hounds) and church turn left onto Innsworth lane. Continue for ½ mile go straight over the mini roundabout and you will see camp on your right. Drive passed the gate to the next mini roundabout passing the Spar shop on your left. You will see camp entrance after the 2nd turning.

- If travelling from London leave the M4 at junction 15 Swindon. Take the 3rd exit A419/417 signed Cirencester. Continue along this road until you reach the Air Balloon Pub on left. The road continues left descending a steep hill. At the 2nd roundabout take 3rd exit signed Ross A40. At the next roundabout take 3rd exit B4063 (Signed Imjin Barracks / HQ ARRC) Follow the instructions above from this point.
