<p>To provide students with the knowledge and skills in Equine Pack Transportation.</p>	<p>On completion of the course the student will be capable of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Handling and leading a horse</li> <li>• Maintaining the animals in a fit and healthy condition by applying the correct rations and care</li> <li>• Maintaining the stables and equipment in a clean and tidy manner</li> <li>• Employing horses and ponies to assist in the transportation of stores and munitions in terrain which is deemed unsuitable for motorised transport</li> <li>• Setting up bivouac sites and base locations</li> <li>• Ensuring all saddlery used is the correct type for the animal being employed and is fitted correctly</li> <li>• Ensuring the loading and sequence of loading are carried out correctly</li> <li>• Demonstrating the First Aid required for basic illness and common injuries found in horses.</li> </ul>
