Hereford is located on the A49 between Ross-on-Wye and Shrewsbury, many believe Hereford to be located in Wales when it is actually located on the English side of the Welsh boarder. Hereford is surrounded by rolling countryside and farmland as well as being a bustling up and coming city centre with plenty of shops and restaurants to suit all tastes.

UNIT OVERVIEW

UNIT FACILITIES

The unit provides many facilities for both serving personnel and dependants. There is a fully equipped Gym which holds circuit training and a climbing club. There is also the Aquatic Centre where the diving club holds dive evenings. Dependants can use the swimming pool during the week and at weekends. All dependants using either the Gym or Aquatic Centre must have personnel liability insurance. Timetables for both of these facilities and necessary forms for insurance are available from the GEMO on camp or from the HIVE.

The Army Learning Centre (ALC) is available to all. There are many courses available both for serving for dependants, some of which are often heavily subsidised. Courses are often available via online with examinations then held at the ALC, contact the ALC for full details.

The Garrison Welfare Office and the Single Personnel HIVE (SPH) are located in the Palud-r-Inn. This SPH is open Thursdays 0900-1500.

In addition there is also a Community Centre on Stirling Estate that is used for various community activities including brownies, scouts and a youth club.

For military personnel there is the Officer's Mess and the WOs'/SGTs' mess and an all ranks bar (Palud-r-Inn) open daily 0930-1400 where you can purchase hot and cold food and the evenings Mon-Thur 1900-2300 (bar only) vending machines available for snacks. The Palud-r-inn also has three Dii terminals where you can access the internet and a free cash machine. The PRI shop is located above the Palud-r-inn and is open Mon- Fri 0915-1130 & 1200 – 1400, you can ring the PRI shop on 01432 357311 ext 2376
