## Section Commanders Battle Course Course No: 478/005

Aim of Course	Outline of Syllabus	Remarks
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To teach Non Commissioned Officers in the operational and administrative duties of a Rifle Section Commander in order to meet the operational requirements of the Infantry, the Army and Defence.

- Course is in two phases
- Phase One Skill at Arms (8 weeks)  
This phase covers methods of instruction, conduct of Skill at Arms lessons, range work and the supervision of live firing
  - Phase Two Tactics (8 weeks).  
This phase covers the tactical command, maintenance and training of a Rifle section.

- Key Training Themes
- As a Section Commander understand and apply the Tactics Techniques and Procedures of an infantry rifle platoon
  - Demonstrate the ability to command an Infantry Section in major combat operations
  - Administer a rifle section
  - Assist and monitor the training of a rifle section.

Rank Range	Entry Standards	Duration	Qualifications gained	Frequency
Lance Corporal to Corporal	IELTS level 6. It is an intensive course and students must be physically fit. Students must also have: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A minimum of two years' service and have been a Lance Corporal (or equivalent) for at least one year</li> <li>Be experienced in the use of Infantry small arms.</li> <li>Be a competent map-reader</li> <li>Be able to use a radio.</li> </ul>	16 weeks	A written report will be produced at the end of the course. Students will be graded Distinction, Pass or Fail.	3 courses per year

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
