LOCAL AREA

Hollywood is a busy small town on the outskirts of Belfast; Palace Bks and Kinnegar Station are within walking distance of Hollywood where you will find everything you need for day to day living and personal administration. There is also a sports centre and many pubs, clubs and restaurants. Hollywood Exchange retail park also has a number of large stores such as Ikea, B&Q and Sainsburys. George Best Belfast City Airport is very close to camp and the ferry port is approximately a 15 minute drive. Belfast is a short distance away and has everything that you would expect to find in a capital city, pubs, clubs, shopping, museums, galleries, hotels and restaurants. The Odyssey Arena is the biggest entertainment centre and houses an events arena, cinemas, pubs, restaurants, ice rink, bowling and more. Bangor and Newtownards are also within easy reach.

TRAVEL

Palace Bks By car: Unit Postcode for Sat Nav is BT18 9RA.

From Belfast take the A2 to Bangor/Hollywood. Keeping Belfast City Airport on your left turn right at the next major junction and pass Tesco on the left. Follow road to second junction and turn left. Keep left and after ¼ mile Palace Bks is on the left.

Kinnegar Station By car: Unit postcode for Sat Nav is BT18 9JT.

From Belfast take the A2 to Bangor/Hollywood keeping Belfast City Airport on your left. Follow road into Hollywood. At the junction just after the train station turn left under a railway bridge. Follow the road passing the Dirty Duck pub on the left. At the junction turn right and follow the road along to the gates of Kinnegar which face the sea.

Before arrival please contact your unit who will provide you with guidelines before you travel. If you are arriving on foot, by sea or air, then you must contact your welfare office who will make arrangements to meet you.

Motoring: On arrival In Northern Ireland, you must register your Privately Owned Vehicle (POV) with the Drivers Vehicle Agency Northern Ireland (DVA NI) if you will be staying for a period of twelve months or more. This is a legal requirement. There is no legal requirement to change to Northern Ireland number plates, but if you would like further advice on this issue then contact the Centralised Risk Assessment Cell on 028 92263601. The purchase of registration plates is an individual responsibility. A list of DVA (NI) authorised outlets is available from the DVA offices.

SECURITY IN NORTHERN IRELAND

Since the end of Op BANNER, life in Northern Ireland for service personnel and their families has improved considerably. However, the unique situation in Northern Ireland means that the military community must pay particular attention to their personal safety. This can be achieved by following a number of measures.

Information on these measures can be obtained by attending a security brief on arrival in Northern Ireland. Service personnel are to receive the Northern Ireland Induction Brief from their unit within 48hrs. A security brief is also available for all families on arrival at Lisburn. This takes place on the first Tuesday on every month at 0930hrs in the community centre. There are many ways to receive up to date security information:

- The Northern Ireland Garrison Security Awareness website is available through DII on the intranet at www.nisyaware.dii.r.mil.uk Unit welfare staff can access this site on behalf of dependents.
- Sign up to your unit's text messaging system via your welfare office and receive information via your mobile phone.
- If you require specific security advice, for example all out of bounds areas, then call the team at the Centralised Risk Assessment Cell (CRAC) on 02892 263601
- Information about out of bound areas can also be obtained from the Northern Ireland Security Guard Service at the main entry point to camp.
- Call the security hotline number where any security notices are recorded on 02892 263937.

Before arriving in Northern Ireland contact your unit for up to date information about both the current security situation and how to travel to your new unit.

If you are at all unsure about how to obtain information on security in Northern Ireland the call any of the Northern Ireland HIVEs or you unit welfare office.
