The S01 Forward Commanders' Course is a 2 ½ day course aimed at preparing S01 Engineer (AS / CE) and Logistics officers for Wing command appointments on Royal Air Force Main Operating Bases and Formed Units. It is strongly recommended that delegates attend the course in advance of commencing a forward command appointment or within the first 3 months of commencing such an appointment.

The syllabus covers a range of topics aimed at providing an update on those issues, initiatives and policies which may have an impact on the delegates' future areas of responsibility within the Forward Command domain. The syllabus includes:

- Engineering and logistics policy
- Supply chain management
- Aviation safety and error management
- Air Command performance and risk management
- Armament management
- A4 FHQ
- A5 Update and EAW Concept
- Information systems
- RAF Continuous Improvement
- Personnel management
- Engineering and logistics branch issues and initiatives
