Application of the principles of range safety to all aspects of battle shooting.</p> <p>Planning, conduct and supervision of Live Firing Tactical Training exercises, including flanking and overhead fire with the general purpose machine gun, (tripod mounted). Destruction of blinds and misfires of ammunition.</p>
