It delivers Joint Fires capability presentations, introduces the principles of Joint Fires integration and practices these techniques at the Battle Group and Company level.	This course is valuable pre-employment training for FPC Commanders, Mortar 2ICs, FACs, FSCC SNCOs BG Ops WO and BG Spt Wpns 2ICs. The course does not include live firing.
