Aim of course

The primary aim of this course is to train Senior Rates to lead personnel in the Fleet. This is carried out by stimulating them to develop their own personal qualities in order to enable them to take charge more effectively. Although primarily a leadership course, it also covers other related subjects such as divisional duties, management, and effective communication.

Outline syllabus

- ◆ Management
- ◆ General Naval knowledge
- ◆ Duties of a Petty Officer
- ◆ Physical Education
- ◆ Communication including parade ground and lecturing
- ◆ First Aid

Entry standards

- ◆ Passed for Petty Officer or due to be advanced within 12 months
- ◆ All students must be in Medical Category P2
- ◆ They must be generally fit as the course includes 1½, 3, and 5 mile runs and a 70 mile trek in the Welsh mountains

Examination / qualifications gained

Continuous assessment with a comprehensive report forwarded on completion of course. A copy of this report is given to the student prior to leaving the school.
