Aim of course

To train students to a sufficient degree of competence to carry out hydrographic fieldwork and data collection, under supervision.

Outline syllabus

Operate selected surveying instruments; conduct selected field observations; assist with the control and maintenance of surveying equipment; rig shore-surveying equipment; assist in the conduct of survey operations afloat; supervise subordinate survey recorders.

Entry standards

- ◆ Practical sea experience as an Able Seaman Survey Recorder (RN requirement is a minimum of 18 months)

Examinations / qualifications gained

Comprehensive written examination lasting 3 days, and continuous assessment in practical subjects.

RN students must attain 50% in each written examination with a 60% overall pass and must achieve specific attainment objectives in practical subjects to become Leading Seaman Survey Recorders.
