UNIT OVERVIEW

The Army Foundation College is located in North Yorkshire close to the market town of Harrogate and conveniently placed for Leeds and York. The Army Foundation College at Harrogate (AFC(H)) trains future soldiers from a wide variety of cap badges. If you are a school leaver aged between 16 and 17 years and one month of age on joining, the AFC(H) offers a unique opportunity to learn as you earn. Through first class military training and vocational education, junior soldiers gain the soldiering skills needed in the modern Army and to get a head start in a challenging and fulfilling career

UNIT FACILITIES

Both Uniacke (AFC) and Hildebrand Barracks (Families) have their own HIVEs where you can find information on all the Unit facilities. There is one HIVE office located in the Jubilee Centre, which caters mainly for the families. The other HIVE office is located in the WRVS Centre, catering for the Junior Soldiers and Single Unaccompanied Permanent Staff. Including a gymnasium (open to all), swimming pool (open to all), Learn Direct Centre, pre-school/crèche and a community centre/. There are a variety of community activities including: Mums and Toddlers, youth clubs (from 4 years and over) , Jujitsu, Pilates, Guides and Brownies.

The Camp is fully equipped with a WRVS facility for Junior Soldiers and single naccompanied Permanent Staff where you can access the internet watch films or just sit and relax. There is also a Junior Soldiers Club. The college has a Spar Shop a Sandes Café, open for both Junior Soldiers and Permanent staff and their families and a Costa Coffee, which is open to the Permanent staff and their families only. There is also a barbers shop, library, Learn Direct Centre and 2 cash point machines.

ESS provides PAYD (in operation for Permanent Staff only- junior soldiers pay food and accommodation charges in lieu of PAYD).

ACCOMMODATION

Service Families Accommodation (SFA)

There are 136 quarters at the Army Foundation College, comprising accommodation ranging from 2 to 5 bedrooms.

123 of these are situated opposite the college but outside the wire on Burley Avenue, Burley Bank Close and Oak Avenue. These SFA are maintained by PPP Infrastructure Management Ltd. All repairs/faults for these SFA should be reported to the PPPML helpdesk on 01423 813376.

The remaining 13 quarters are situated in Central Harrogate approximately 3.5 miles from the Unit at Hilltop Drive (HG1 3BU) and Hilltop Walk (HG1 3BX).
