Thank you for your Freedom of Information requests of 23 June 2008 asking for copies of all files and reports associated with an alleged incident involving a police helicopter and a UFO near Cardiff on 8th June 2008.

Other than being aware of the incident via the media and members of the public such as yourself asking for information on the subject, the MoD has not received any report on the incident and therefore has no file on the matter. I can confirm however, that military radar reported no unusual activity for the time in question.

If you are unhappy with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Director of Information Exploitation, 6th Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail Info-XD@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain unhappy following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate the case until the internal review process has been completed.
