<p>This new MSc programme aims to generate in-depth knowledge and understanding of what constitutes security in the 21st century and the place and relevance of military force in helping to solve its multi-dimensional problems.</p>	<p>The course comprises 5 compulsory and 2 elective modules, followed by a 20,000 word dissertation.</p> <p>Compulsory modules: In the first term, students take foundation modules on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Research Methodology • The Development of Military Operations, Doctrine and Strategic Thought • Security, Demography and the Physical Environment • International Law of War and the Use of Force. <p>In the second term, they take the core module:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Nature of Security <p>During this second term, students also take two electives chosen from:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Disaster Management • Weapons of Mass Destruction, their Control and Verification • Terrorism • Security in the Asia-Pacific Rim • Security Policy of Russia and the Soviet Union • Management of Defence in a Democracy. <p>Cranfield University does not guarantee to offer all electives in a given year but every effort will be made to meet students' wishes.</p> <p>In the third term, students complete the dissertation, which may be in any area covered in the course.</p>	<p>Capacity is 30 personnel.</p>
