## **SECTION 1 - MM 27/4 - UNITED STATES AIR FORCE (USAF) - UNITED STATES NAVY (USN) - RAF STORES CLASSIFICATION**

### **PURPOSE**

1. The purpose of this Leaflet is to describe the methods used to assign an RAF Class of Store to American sourced items provisioned by the United Kingdom through FMS.

### **USAF ITEMS**

2. The USAF Expandability - Recoverability - Reparability Category (ERRC) Codes, shown against items listed in the USAF Supply Manual (AFMAN23-110), are converted to the RAF Class of Store by MDGs using the table at Annex A.

### **USN ITEMS**

3. In assigning the RAF Class of Store, MDGs take into account the USN Source, Maintenance and Recoverability (SM & R) Code and the value of the item and seek engineering advice.

4. SM & R Codes are shown against items listed in the USN catalogues P2300 - List of Repairable Assemblies of Navy Aviation Materials and P2310 - List of Supporting Repair Parts of Navy Aviation Materials. P2999 - Foreword for P2300 and P2310 contains an explanation of current SM & R codes and a cross reference from old to new codes.

1. Expendable items are either consumed in use, become a part of a higher assembly during periods of use or have a unit cost of less than \$10.00.
2. A small number of Code N items are in fact, repairable and are classified as P class stores.
