LOCAL AREA

Arborfield Garrison is set in the Berkshire countryside on the edge of Arborfield village, 4 miles from Wokingham and 8 miles from Reading and 6 miles from junction 11 on the M4. London (35 miles away) is an hour by train and there are plenty of other sightseeing opportunities within easy reach including Thorpe Park and Legoland. Reading, the nearest big town, has much to offer such as excellent shopping, restaurants, pubs, clubs, theatres, as well as the Madejski Stadium - home to Reading FC and London Irish RUFC.

UNIT OVERVIEW

The Garrison comprises of two barracks, Rowcroft and Hazebrouck.

Hazebrouck Barracks is the home of the Corps of REME and has DEME(A), RHQ REME, SEAE, 11 Training Battalion, REME Arms School, and DCAE.

DEME(A) comprises of HQ DEME(A), Regimental Headquarters REME and the REME Museum of Technology.

SEAE (School of Electronic and Aeronautical Engineering) provides a wide range of courses to train electronic and aviation technicians and engineers.

REME Arms School delivers training in REME command skills and engineering management to officers, soldiers and equipment support staff.

DCAE (Defence College of Aeronautical Engineering) commands and manages aeronautical training.

Rowcroft Barracks is the home of REME Corps Band.

UNIT FACILITIES

Arborfield Garrison provides a wide variety of facilities. On the camp there is a fully equipped gym, barbers and tailors. Dependants can also use the gym.

The Welfare Centre has the HIVE, the Padre and Unit Welfare Office. Also Services Welfare have TV lounges, snooker tables, table tennis tables, pool tables, games area and internet suite all for your use.

Passes for the barracks can be obtained via SEAE HQ (the building with the revolving doors).

The Garrison Church is located close to the entrance to Rowcroft Barracks and near the Community Centre.

The Community Centre houses a Hairdresser, Beauty Therapist, various clubs and activities as well a nursery, pre-school and the Army Learning Centre. All the facilities are available for use by all members of the Garrison community. The centre can be booked for parties and events. TRAVEL

By car: Unit Postcode for Sat Nav is RG2 9NH

- From the M4, exit at junction 11, take the exit for Whitley Wood (also says Reading University) B3270.
- At the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto A327, go past the Black Boy Pub.
- At the next roundabout take the 1st exit.
- At the next roundabout take the 1st exit to stay on the A327.
- Follow this to Arborfield village, at the roundabout take the 3rd exit.
- At the next roundabout take the 1st exit onto Langley Common Road.
- Take 1st right onto Biggs Lane, the garrison is on the left hand side.

By train: The closest station is Wokingham (3.3m from the garrison) and offers a direct line from Reading, Gatwick and London.
