Thank you for your e-mail of 22 November 2007 asking if I could double check the response provided to you on 16 March 2005 under reference 01-03-2005-13581-007 regarding an alleged UFO incident at Llanilar, near Aberystwyth, in January 1983.

I can confirm the MoD has no record of this incident. The Directorate of Air Staff UFO files covering this period have been placed in The National Archive and are now available for examination by the public at The National Archives, Ruskin Avenue, Kew, Richmond, Surrey, TW9 4DU, Telephone: 0208 876 3444. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate the case until the internal review process has been completed.
