<p>The aim of the Auxiliary Supply Basic Training course is to equip selected trainees with the necessary skills, knowledge and attitudes so that they can carry out the duties associated with the Job Description of a Supplier RAuxAF.</p>	<p>The training follows a modular format, with the trainee acquiring only those skills required to perform basic tasks. As the course progresses the skill areas are enhanced enabling the trainee to perform more complex tasks. Emphasis is placed on maintaining progress and measurable achievement alongside developing the competence to perform specific work related tasks. Trainees learn by carrying out practical as well as theory based assignments. They will handle equipment and use real documentation and procedures from the outset. Modules covered by the course include: Health & Safety at Work Act / Environmental Protection/ Control of Substances Hazardous to Health, RAF Supply Organisation, Communications, Quality Assurance, Supply Publications, Principles of Supply Accounting, Stock Control, Storekeeping Skills, Secondary Accounting, Procedures and Organisation MJDI, Receipt and Dispatch, Fuels and Lubricants, Procedures Specialized.</p>
