## **Trials Management Course No: 402/076**

Aim of Course	Outline of Syllabus	Remarks
<p>The aim of this course is to provide an introduction to the management of trials, including some of the techniques used in the planning, conduct and analysis of trials. The course is designed for serving officers or senior NCOs and civilians of officer status who are concerned, or are likely to be concerned, with trials. The course is suitable for those who hold trials appointments in trials units, experimental and research establishments or units responsible for conducting a trial. Operational requirements staff and those about to assume a trials appointment or be given responsibility for planning or supervising trials as part of a project will find the course valuable.</p>	<p><b>Objectives</b>            To give students an understanding of the trials management task and to promote the use of modern management techniques in the planning, control, reporting and administration of trials.</p> <p>To make students aware of the MOD planning environment within which the trials manager must work.</p> <p>To gain experience on the planning and conduct of trials from service and commercial trials practitioners and through a practical trials exercise.</p> <p>To give students an awareness of the application of statistical and operational analysis techniques which provide a numerate and objective foundation for planning trials and analysing their results.</p>	<p>Capacity is 20 personnel.</p>
