Aim

To provide instructors with the necessary techniques to train conscripts, contracted soldiers and professional soldiers in conventional military skills





General Points

- 1 course per year
- 6 weeks long
- 30 students per course





Students

- Rank Range Sgt – Capt
- Pitched at Army but all services welcome
- Students will return to units and deliver the training received on BMATT (CZ) course
- The training will cascade down and create more instructors in the unit providing them with a workable instructor base
- The BMATT (CZ) trained instructors are vital during the ICTT deployments



Training Objectives and Content

- Plan, Conduct and Supervise Military Training
- Understand the UN Standard Generic Training Modules
- Core Skills
 - Lectures and Demonstrations
 - Methods of Instruction
 - Instructor Lessons
 - Student Lessons – at least 7 each
 - Supervision of instruction
 - Coaching
 - Fieldcraft
 - Rifle
 - Pistol
 - Grenades
 - Range work – up to IBSR
 - Battle Lessons/Exercise





Course Structure

- Week 1 & 2 – MOI and IP. Lectures, demonstrations and lessons.
- Week 3 – Battle Lessons, MOI.
- Week 4 – Rangework.
- Week 5 – Battle Exercises, MOI and Fieldcraft.
- Week 6 – Student led demos and MOI.
