<p>To train Officers of the Supply Branch, WOs and NCOs of the supply trade, to fill posts directly associated with the operation of Petroleum Supply Depot (PSD) Ocean Terminals.</p>	<p>Topics covered by the course include: Ocean Terminal Management, Ocean Tanker Design, Actions Prior, During and After an Ocean Tanker Discharge, Accounting and Documentation, Practical Operations, Marine Pollution. The first 3 days of the course are carried out at RAF Halton, the course then deploys to Cyprus, Ascension or the Falkland Islands, to carry out the practical phase (Ship to Shore operations). The practical exam requires 75% to pass, theory 60%.</p>	<p>Location, RAF Halton</p>
