RIGID INFLATABLE BOAT COURSE

Aim of course

To teach students basic navigation and boat work theory, leading to practical instruction in being a small craft coxswain.

Outline syllabus

Students will undertake a one week RIB course which will be boat specific, to students' unit requirement.

The course will comprise of a day in the class room learning basic navigation and boat work, followed by 3 days of practical boat instruction. The final day of the course will be a practical assessment and written exams in Navigation and boat work.

Entry standards

Moderate level of English required.

Examinations/qualifications gained

On successful completion of the course students will be issued an RN s3205 boat coxswains log book stamped with craft type student was instructed in.
