Entry standards

- ◆ Course is targeted primarily at Lieutenant Commanders or Lieutenants appointed as Heads of Department or as senior watch keepers in surface ships and submarines or as Executive Officers of Naval Air Squadrons. It is also suitable for Warrant Officers and selected Senior Ratings involved in the planning of Maritime Warfare
- ◆ The security level of the course is NATO Secret

A pre-course reading list is included with the joining instructions. A curriculum vitae with full professional details covering operational background, recent tactical experience, last job and next job is required 8 weeks before joining the course.
