To train overseas Logistic Officers in Army Logistic services, responsibilities and functions.

The course gives a sound grounding in materials management and military logistics from Unit-level upwards. Instruction covers a broad spectrum of logistics operations and management and on completion of the course the students should be able to enact logistics training in their own countries.

Subject Areas

- Overview of Defence, British Army and Land Logistics.
- Overview of UN, Coalition and Multinational Logistic Structures.
- British Logistic doctrine.
- Introduction to the Military Decision Making Process (MDMP).
- Visit logistic locations and learn about the management of, and UK training in fuel commodities, food services, transport, warehousing/storage, ammunition, port operations and air dispatch.
- The support chain and the supply chain.
- Inventory management and visibility.
- Cultural visits.
