Week 1 (Classroom):

- ◆ Course Introduction
- ◆ Manual TMA
- ◆ Periscope Safety and Drills
- ◆ RN Navigation/Pool of Errors
- ◆ General Operations Plot – Introduction and Analysis
- ◆ Local Operations Plot – Introduction and Analysis
- ◆ Prevention of Mutual Interference

Week 2 (DOLPHIN Attack Teacher/Simulator):

- ◆ Periscope drills/techniques/safety
- ◆ Periscope ranging, visual assessment of ATB and DOT
- ◆ Close Quarter Drills
- ◆ 1-3 ship runs, DOT problems, manual TMA, ATB and DOT/LOP evaluation, clearing stern arcs
- ◆ Navigation and Pool of Errors

Remarks

This course can be tailored to suit individual nation's requirements. This course can also be run in conjunction with the Officers' Submarine Foundation Course. RN Officer students complete both courses prior to joining their first submarine.
