BASIC SEA SAFETY

Aim of course

Mandatory PJT for all RN Officers and Ratings before proceeding to sea for the first time.

Outline syllabus

Topics covered include:

- ◆ Firefighting organisation, equipment and techniques (1 day)
- ◆ One day of practical fire fighting (1 day)
- ◆ Sea survival theory and practical drills (1 day)
- ◆ CBRNDC theory, organisation, communications, states and conditions, and incident board marking (1 day)
- ◆ CBRN hazards, individual protective equipment and CBRN cleansing procedures. (½ day)
- ◆ Practical damage control (½ day)

Examinations / qualifications gained

MCA Certificate in 'Personal Survival Techniques' and 'Fire Prevention and Fire Fighting'.

Remarks

- ◆ International students should constitute a complete course (minimum 12, maximum 24)
- ◆ Course includes practical drills in CBRN (in a CS gas environment), fire fighting, damage control and sea survival
- ◆ Respirators are required for this course. Students are encouraged to bring their own national issue respirator
