Thank you for your Freedom of Information request of 22 November 2007 asking for details of the scrambling of two fighter jets to investigate an alleged UFO incident at Felpham in West Sussex on 4 October 2007. You also asked for copies of any pictures or reports of the alleged unknown objects taken by the pilots or the MoD.

No aircraft were scrambled to investigate this matter. The alleged sighting has not been reported to this office which acts as the focal point for UFO reports across the MoD. We are therefore unaware of any reports or photographs of the alleged incident.

If you are unhappy with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Director of Information Exploitation, 6th Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail Info-XD@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain unhappy following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate the case until the internal review process has been completed.
