Thank you for your e-mail of 5 March 2008 asking whether the subject of UFOs is the most requested Freedom of Information topic. Your e-mail is being treated as a Freedom of Information request.

The Ministry of Defence does not hold statistics that readily answer this question, however, I can confirm that for the year 2007, requests on the subject of UFOs formed 5.22% of the total number of FOI requests received by the Ministry of Defence.

If you are unhappy with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of this request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Director of Information Exploitation, 6th Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall SW1A 2HB (e-mail InfoXD@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain unhappy following an internal review, you may wish to take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the internal process has been completed.
