#### **LOCAL AREA**

Haverfordwest is the county town of Pembrokeshire which is the most western county in Wales. Haverfordwest is described as the gateway to Britain's most westerly National Park along the Pembrokeshire Coast. The National Park offers rugged cliffs and islands, tree-lined estuaries and open moorlands. The town is located a short walk from the SFA and offers a range of high street shops, an indoor market, post office and banks as well as a choice of supermarkets. There is also a leisure centre and cinema. Every other Friday there is a Farmer's Market, which is held on the riverside complex.

#### **UNIT OVERVIEW**

14th Signal Regiment was formed in 1959 from the United Kingdom Commonwealth Communications Army Network Signal Regiment, taking on the responsibility for world-wide communications on behalf of the British Army and later forming as 14th Signal Regiment (Electronic Warfare) in 1977 to provide Commander 1st British Corps with electronic warfare support. By 1978 the Regiment had settled in Celle, Germany where it remained until 1993. In December 1995 the Germany based elements moved to Cawdor Barracks near Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire, with 237 Signal Squadron (Electronic Warfare) joining them in Brawdy six months later following a tour in Bosnia. Today the Regiment remains ready to provide modern highly capable electronic warfare resources packaged to meet the demands of either NATO or National Forces deployed worldwide.

The Regiment retains the Freedom of Entry into Gloucester and the Freedom of Celle, and has been honoured with the Freedom of St Davids since 1997 and the Freedom of Haverfordwest since 2008.

## UNIT FACILITIES

Cawdor Barracks provides a wide variety of amenities including a Gymnasium, which is open to all service personnel and their dependants, squash courts, library, education centre, golf club, angling club, clay pigeon shooting club, sub aqua club, Raggi's Bar (Jnr Ranks), and Sgt's and Officers Mess'. The Hub incorporates a TV lounge with table games, tea/coffee facilities, reading area and internet computers.

On Cashfield Estate where SFA is located, there is a Community centre which hosts Youth Club, Mums & Tots and a structured play scheme called Chimps. Other activities such as Brownies, Rainbows, Cubs etc are held at Furzy Community Centre on Dale Estate. Both Centres can be booked for parties and events. **By car:** Unit Postcode for Sat Nav is SA62 6NN

### Directions to Cawdor Barracks:

- From Carmarthen take A40 to Haverfordwest.
- Follow the A40 signed St Davids/Fishguard.
- Go over the traffic lights (County Hotel on left corner) and at the next roundabout turn left onto A487 signed St David's.
- Go straight over the small roundabout and then turn right at the next roundabout.
- Follow the (A487) passing through Simpson Cross, Newgale and Pennycwm and the camp is approx  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile on your right (signposted).

Cawdor Barracks is approximately 16 miles from Haverfordwest and transport is provided from the SFA locations.

### Directions to Cashfield Estate:

- From Carmarthen take A40 to Haverfordwest.
- Follow the A40 signed St Davids/Fishguard.
- Over traffic lights (County Hotel on left corner), at the next roundabout turn left onto A487 signed St David's.
- At small roundabout turn right (5<sup>th</sup> exit) B4330 signed Croes-goch.
- Travel up Crow Hill passing St Martins Park and Redhill on your left and Cashfield Way is next left.
