LOCAL AREA

Canterbury is located in South East Kent and is a 15 minute drive from the M2 providing easy access to Central London. The ports of Dover and Folkestone are approximately 30 minutes drive away.

Local facilities in Canterbury include a leisure centre, a bowling and skating centre, an Odeon cinema, The Marlowe Theatre, a golf club and Whitefriars Shopping Centre. Three Zoo and wildlife parks also lie within a 15 mile radius of Howe Barracks, which are open all year round. There are also Community centres in Canterbury including one at the Barracks, all of which offer Sure Start facilities for toddlers, as well as adult and children's clubs and activities.

In Canterbury's wider area the towns of Broadstairs, Sandwich and Whitstable all have excellent shopping, leisure facilities and restaurants and are easily accessed by road and rail.

UNIT OVERVIEW

5 SCOTS - The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders, 5th Battalion The Royal Regiment of Scotland (5 SCOTS) is based at Howe Barracks in Canterbury. It is an Air Assault Battalion and part of 16 Air Assault Brigade, Britain's Rapid Reaction Force. The unit was deployed between Sep 2010 and Mar 2011.

3 PWRR - 3 PWRR is the Territorial Army Infantry Battalion for the South East of England. Its soldiers train on Wednesday evenings and on one weekend a month, plus an annual training period of two weeks - in the UK or abroad. HQ Coy is based in Leros Barracks just 0.5 miles away from Howe Barracks.

UNIT FACILITIES

The "20/Twenty Club" located in camp contains a Spar shop a licensed bar showing all major sporting events on large screen television, the PRI shop and a cafe which is open until 1900 hrs and 1700 hrs at weekends. An internet suite is also available for all to use at a nominal cost.

"Colours" restaurant also provides breakfast, lunch and evening meals to serving personnel on PAYD. Families are also welcome to use this facility

A gym is free to use by all, subject to having an induction course. Other sports facilities provided by the unit include football pitches and pitches located outside the SFA which hold sporting events all year round.

A LearnDirect facility is available within camp offering free courses to soldiers and families.

The community centre hosts many activities for the local community including parent and toddler groups and both adult and children's clubs and activities. For telephone numbers of the Community Development Worker who manages the centre, contact the HIVE.

A pre-school is also located within camp which provides government funded childcare for children aged 2+.
